Dear Staff and Families of Woodlawn High School:

Our school’s Leadership Team had an opportunity to collaborate regarding our virtual bell schedule for the fall. We carefully considered student social emotional and academic needs, stakeholder input and the impact of COVID-19 on our school community. We will implement a 4x4 semesterized meeting schedule for our students. This change will reduce students course load to 4 classes per semester (8 total per school year) rather than the 8 classes at once offered on the traditional A/B day Schedule.
